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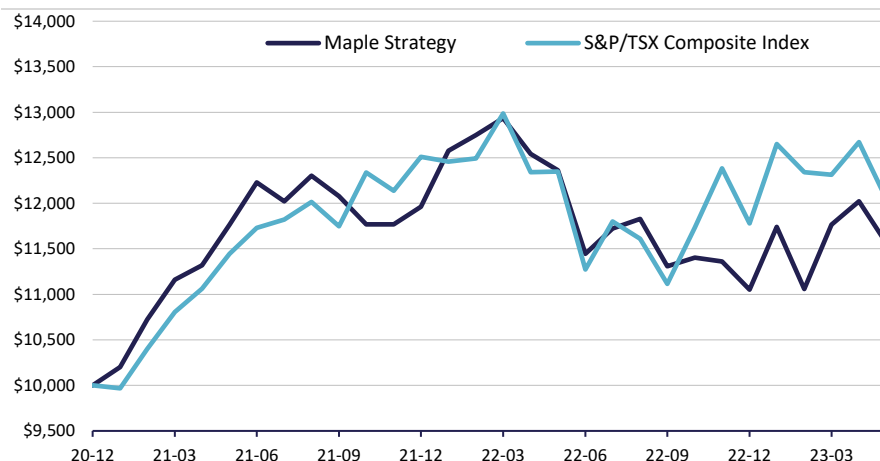
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Description

The philosophy behind the Maple strategy is to capture the best sector returns of the S&P/TSX Composite Index over time. Alpha is generated by exploiting correlations between sectors in the index and adding quantitative momentum weighted signals. The strategy selects only the most attractive sectors and dynamically manages

the weightings of each. The Maple strategy adds an element of risk management by reducing the negative impact of a market correction by investing in a U.S. dollar position when the strategy detects a downside risk.
